

ORDINANCE NO. 2009-17

AN ORDINANCE OF IVINS CITY, UTAH, AMENDING SECTION 7.05.302(2) OF THE IVINS CITY CODE REGARDING THE DURATION OF HANDBILL PERMITS

WHEREAS, the Ivins City Council desires to amend Section 7.05.302(2) of the Ivins City Code regarding the duration of handbill permits;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF IVINS CITY, STATE OF UTAH:

SECTION 1. Section 7.05.302(2) of the Ivins City Code is amended to now read as follows:

7.05.302 ISSUANCE OF A COMMERCIAL HANDBILL PERMIT; DURATION.

\* \* \*

(2) The duration of a commercial handbill permit shall be for thirty (30) days. In the event the applicant desires to engage in ongoing distributions of handbills throughout the year and there have been no violations of this Part during the initial thirty (30) day permit period, then the applicant may apply for an annual handbill permit having a duration of one (1) year from the date of issuance.

SECTION 2. Severability. If any section, clause or portion of this ordinance is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and publication.
