

## RESOLUTION No. 2018-14R

### A RESOLUTION OF IVINS CITY, UTAH, AUTHORIZING A CREDIT TOWARD PAYING UTILITY BILLS FOR ACTIVATED GUARD AND RESERVE MILITARY PERSONNEL

WHEREAS, Ivins City has a number of residents who are members of the National Guard or Reservists who are called to active duty from time to time; and

WHEREAS, these men and women who serve in the National Guard or Reserves are often sacrificing income to serve the people of the United States and the citizens of Ivins City, and

WHEREAS, the activation of these individuals has often created a financial hardship on their families; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of the service and sacrifice of the men and women serving their country, and protecting residents of Ivins City and throughout the country, Ivins City adopted Resolution 2006-09R which provided a credit for active military as set forth in the Resolution; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 2006-09 has become outdated and it is necessary to adopt a new Resolution to help mitigate financial hardships on their families created by their service;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF IVINS CITY, STATE OF UTAH, THAT:**

1. Ivins City will credit the base fees of the utilities (currently set at \$23.90 water, \$22.11 sewer, \$15.79 garbage/recycling, \$10.79 storm drain and \$1.75 Washington County Water Conservancy District fee, totaling \$74.34) toward the monthly utility bill of Ivins City residents who have a member of the household in the National Guard or reservists who have been activated to full-time military duty.
2. In order to qualify for the credit, the activated household member must be a resident of Ivins City.
3. The person, or family member, shall establish eligibility by bringing a copy of the United States military activation papers to the City Office.
4. The credit shall be effective from the date proof of military activation is provided to the City until the date when the qualified person is released from active duty.
5. The credit shall be paid from the City's water enterprise funds.

**Effective Date: This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption by the City Council.**
